

Nunavut Provincial Health Insurance Plan: Fact Sheet

Services Provided by Nunavut Health Care Plan and Extended Health Benefits (EHB):

Prescription Drugs	 Seniors 65+ and residents with chronic conditions receive full drug coverage under EHB. Residents with private insurance receive top-up or additional coverage: 80% if partially covered by insurer, 100% if denied (with pre-approval). Inuit and First Nations residents receive prescription drug coverage through the federal NIHB program.
Ambulance	 Coverage for medically necessary inter-hospital transfers Medevac flights within Nunavut arranged by government; residents pay a \$250 deductible (\$125 each way). No coverage for ground or air ambulance outside Nunavut.
Dental Benefits	 No coverage for routine dental care. Coverage limited to medically necessary oral and jaw surgeries performed in hospital.
Eye Care Services	 Coverage for ophthalmology services: exams, medical/ surgical treatments, and intraocular lenses (IOLs) once per eye. No coverage for routine optometry or glasses.
Hospitals	Coverage for standard ward rooms only.
Hearing Aids	 No general coverage. EHB provides coverage for seniors (65+) for one set every 5 years. Inuit and First Nations residents may receive full coverage under NIHB.



Services Provided by Nunavut Health Care Plan and Extended Health Benefits (EHB):

Medical Supplies	 EHB covers prescribed medical equipment and supplies for seniors and eligible conditions (e.g., wheelchairs, respiratory devices).
Nursing and Home Care Benefits	Home and Community Care program offers nursing care, personal care, homemaking, respite, and rehabilitation support, based on assessed need.
Paramedical	 Coverage only for hospital-based services such as radiotherapy and occupational therapy. No coverage for private physiotherapy, chiropractic, massage therapy, or podiatry.
Out of Country	 Reciprocal coverage across Canada (except Quebec). Outside Canada, services reimbursed at Nunavut rates only; residents responsible for balance. No ambulance coverage outside Nunavut.
