## P.E.I. Provincial Health Insurance Plan: Fact Sheet

# Services Provided by the P.E.I. Hospital and Medical Services Insurance Plan:

#### Prescription Drugs

- Under the Seniors' Drug Program, residents aged 65 and over are eligible for coverage of the cost of approved medications. Seniors must pay \$8.25 plus \$7.69 of the pharmacy professional fee for each eligible prescription filled. Remaining eligible costs will be covered by the Program.
- Coverage for eligible residents under specific programs such as the Diabetes Drug Program, the Family Health Benefit Drug Program, etc.

#### **Ambulance**

- There is no charge for ground ambulance for those 65 and over when being transported to a P.E.I. hospital emergency department.
- There is no charge for all residents when they are transferred from one hospital to another upon the referral of a physician.
- There is no charge for emergency air ambulance when the patient is transported from P.E.I. to a referred hospital out of province.

#### Dental Benefits

- Certain oral surgery procedures performed by an oral surgeon when it is medically necessary that they be performed in a hospital.
- Preventative dental health services for children from birth to 17 under the School Oral Health Preventative Program.
- Special program for children born with a cleft palate.
- Individuals or families who earn a low income may be eligible to receive subsidized basic dental treatment services under the Provincial Dental Care Program.
- The Canadian Dental Care Plan (CDCP) is covered by the federal government

#### Eye Care Services

No coverage for routine eye exams.

Hospitals	Coverage for standard ward rooms only.
Hearing Aids	<ul> <li>Seniors Hearing Aid Rebate Program covers costeffective hearing aids for eligible residents to a maximum payable rebate of \$6,000 per individual.</li> <li>Payable once every 5 years.</li> </ul>
Medical Supplies	Coverage available under specific programs, such as the Ostomy Supplies Program, Home Oxygen Program, etc.
Nursing and Home Care Benefits	<ul> <li>Based on assessed need, home care and support services are provided through the Home Care Program.</li> </ul>
Paramedical	<ul> <li>Coverage for physiotherapy when performed in a hospital.</li> <li>No coverage for audiologists, chiropodists, chiropractors, dietitians, homeopaths, naturopaths, optometrists, osteopaths, physiotherapists, podiatrists, and psychologists.</li> </ul>
Out of Country	Coverage for emergency or sudden illness will be provided at P.E.I. rates in Canadian currency.
